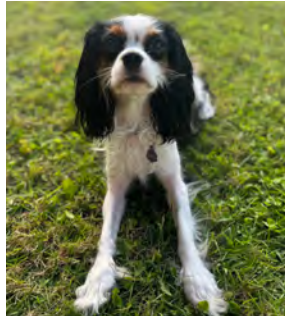

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING VACCINATION:**

Effective Jan 1, 2012, due to changes in the State and County rabies laws, exemption from rabies vaccination can only be granted by the County Veterinary Public Health Department. More information and Application for Exemption available at your local Veterinarian office.

To improve health tracking, local Veterinarians must report rabies vaccination records to the City of Manhattan Beach.

### LICENSING FEES



Sterile Animal (with proof):	<b>\$23</b>
Intact Animal:	<b>\$51</b>
Replacement Tag:	<b>\$4</b>

- Keep your pet's rabies vaccination current.
- Renew annually and maintain a current Animal License.
- Visit our online portal to apply, renew, and pay easily.
- Enjoy your lifetime tag at renewal.

### LICENSING AND RABIES VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Dogs 4 months or older residing in the City for more than 30 days are required to be licensed.(M.B.M.C. 5.01.140).

**Current Rabies Vaccination Certificate is required in order for a license to be issued.**

- Vaccination status or invoice will not be accepted
- Certificate must include lot/serial number of vaccine
