THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH CITY COUNCIL WILL CONDUCT A  
PUBLIC HEARING TO INTRODUCE AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
SECTIONS OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE AND THE  
MANHATTAN BEACH LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM RELATED TO THE  
LONG-TERM OUTDOOR DINING PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

Applicant: City of Manhattan Beach

Project Location: Citywide

Project Description: On August 24, 2021, the City Council provided direction to staff to pursue a work plan item to study a long-term program for outdoor dining. Since then, the City Council approved the formation of a 15-member ad hoc task force to develop the program. The task force held 15 meetings, and five status reports have been presented to the City Council (at its September 5, 2023, February 20, 2024, April 16, 2024, October 1, 2024, and March 11, 2025 meetings). The City Council will consider the proposed amendments to the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code and Manhattan Beach Local Coastal Program related to the long-term outdoor dining program development, which have been reviewed and recommended for approval by the Parking and Public Improvements Commission on April 24, 2025, and by the Planning Commission on October 22, 2025.

Environmental  
Determination:

A draft Initial Study (IS) was prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined that a Negative Declaration (ND) was the appropriate environmental document. A draft ND was prepared and circulated for public comments for 31 days, starting on August 22, and concluding on September 22, 2025. As detailed within the final ND, adoption of the proposed code amendments to the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code and Manhattan Beach Local Coastal Program would not result in any potentially significant environmental impacts.
