THE MANHATTAN BEACH PLANNING COMMISSION WILL CONDUCT A STUDY SESSION TO DISCUSS AND CONSIDER AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING OUTDOOR DINING REGULATIONS IN THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE AND MANHATTAN BEACH LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM TO UPDATE OPERATIONAL STANDARDS BASED ON RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE OUTDOOR DINING TASK FORCE

Project

Description: On August 24, 2021, the City Council provided direction to staff to pursue a work plan item to study a long-term program for outdoor dining. Since then, the City Council approved the formation of a 15-member ad hoc task force to develop the program. The task force has held 15 meetings and five status reports have been presented to the City Council (at its September 5, 2023, February 20, 2024, April 16, 2024, October 1, 2024, and March 11, 2025, meetings). At the March 11, 2025, meeting, the City Council directed staff to initiate amendments to the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code and Manhattan Beach Local Coastal Program based on the outdoor dining task force's recommendations related to operational standards for outdoor dining.

Environmental

Determination: The proposed code amendments are subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and are being analyzed accordingly. The associated environmental documents are anticipated to be completed in late summer, prior to the Planning Commission and City Council's formal consideration of the proposed code amendments.
